

The CWL is conducting a petition drive this weekend that we hope will quell proposed legislative changes that will affect all of us.

- 1....to protect charitable status of faith-based and pro -life organizations, and
- 2....to stop the expansion of medical assistance in dying (MAiD) to include advanced requests

If we don't protest and allow these changes to the law—

- Pro-life organizations will lose their charitable status:
- These changes will threaten the survival of faith organizations that provide community services such as food banks, soup kitchens, hospitals, schools, daycares, long-term care homes and palliative care centres.
- These changes will permit the expansion of MAiD, to include advanced requests following a diagnosis leading to incapacity. We should instead urge the federal government to focus on enhancing palliative and hospice care rather than ending the lives of people in need.


